

Minutes of March 16, 2010
Twin Lakes Golf Association

Pres. Bennett called meeting to order at 1:30pm.

Board members present: Bennett, Clifford, Day, Frauenfelder, Humpfer, Pavlak, Walker

Secretary Humpfer read minutes of 2/16/10. Minutes approved as read.

Treas. D. Day reported we began February with \$73,900. in the bank. \$71,000. was collected in dues and fees. \$1,800. collected from the pro shop. \$19,256. were paid in expenses compared to \$45,000. (ice storm) in 2009 leaving an ending balance of \$129,000. Effective March 1st TLGA had \$124,000. in accounts receivables, month to date we have collected \$50,000. leaving \$75,000. outstanding. Treasurer Day will begin contacting delinquent members.

Operations: R. Frauenfelder reported the pro shop is in the process of getting new brochures to be distributed to the Chamber and businesses locally. Summer rates will begin April 1st. Fees will be same as 2009. Cindy Isabel from ASUMH will evaluate the computer issues plaguing our operation. Don White has agreed to pay her fees involved in the evaluation. The current system is not operator friendly, not compatible with Karen's accounting system, lacks software support and is difficult to use. Hopefully the hardware is salvable and new software will be the quick fix.

Grounds and Greens: J. Clifford reviewed that the tractor has been repaired. Tee # 6 the signs were moved and the trees have been trimmed. This allows for different placement of the tees for the men. The chipping area will be positioned behind the practice green. If wayward balls coming from #1 tee box become a problem then the fence will be raised. Hanging limbs are being removed on the left side of #10. When this project is completed the out of bound ropes will be taken down. New white flags and poles have been ordered. Mike Good has been given a two year contract extension.

Buildings: F. Pavlak stated the sewer lines have been cleaned. The broken glass was replaced. The water fountain on #12 has been hung and is functioning. The three outer doors will be ordered from Ozark Door at \$175.00 per unit. Currently there are 14 vacant sheds.

Tournaments: M. Walker announced the first tournament of the season is 4/24/10. It is the J. Douglas Memorial.

Old Business: Door replacements and window repair covered in Mr. Pavlak's report.

New Business: Jody Horne and Mike Coots were voted as new members. Wilmer Spear and Arthur Marohn were granted Honorary Membership. Letters of non renewal were received from Ron McHenry and Robert Mohr.

Mr. Bennett acknowledged the Ladies League for their \$300. contribution toward the cost of the replacement doors.

Misc. items: Doug Mycue stated he will hold up on the purchase of two additional rental carts and extension of the cart barn until the club's finances are more stable.

The fee for non members playing in leagues are the same as guest rates (\$10. for nine and \$15.00 for eighteen)

Meeting adjourned at 2:33 pm.
